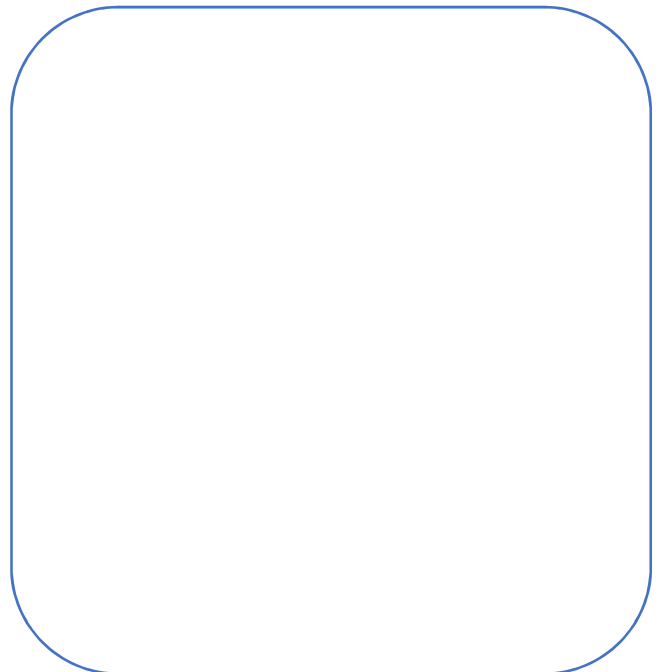

THE TWELVE DISCIPLES



Jesus had twelve very close friends who traveled with him. They were his disciples.

Disciples are followers of Christ.

The names of Jesus' disciples were: Simon (who is called Peter) and his brother Andrew; James son of Zebedee, and his brother John; Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus; Simon the Zealot and Judas Iscariot, who betrayed him.

Jesus told his disciples to preach to "the lost sheep of Israel" that the kingdom of heaven was near. The disciples were also instructed to heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those with leprosy, and to drive out demons.

Jesus told them not to bring anything with them. The disciples were to find a worthy person in each town or village and stay in his house until they left. Sometimes people did not welcome the disciples or listen to their words. If this happened the disciples were to shake the dust off their feet when they left.
